## Abuse and Neglect

- ► The most destructive experiences for early developmental delay.
- ▶ Trust, personal control, hope are all diminished.
- ▶ Unsafe, ego-centric people are not functioning well.
- What can we do to help them ?

#### Attachment Difficulties

- Nobody cares about me.
- ▶ I have to fend for myself.
- Social viewpoint of the average 2-3 year old.
- ▶ No one does anything that they don't get paid for.
- ▶ No experience of being cared for, so it doesn't exist.

#### Attachment Needs

- ▶ An experience of someone really caring about me.
- A belief that I deserve to be loved and cared for.
- Becoming aware of caring for others as a satisfying experience.
- Belief that people are basically nice to each other without getting paid for it.
- ▶ Trust that I won't be victimized by others.

#### CYC Practical Ideas

- Focus on caring, not controlling and teaching responsibility.
- Don't get paid by requesting a "Thank you".
- ▶ Random acts of caring.
- ▶ Being nice to a youth who doesn't behave well.
- Forgiving quickly and easily.

## Creating Other Awareness

- ▶ Social sense requires this awareness.
- Relational connection starts the process.
- ▶ The youth becomes sensitive to her impact on you.
- Experience caring for plants, pets, etc.
- Expand the view of other.

#### Personal Control and Power Issues

- Youth and families feel hopeless and powerless.
- Anger and aggression are usual responses to no power.
- ▶ Passive acceptance with no commitment to change is another response.
- Authority figures have all the control and I have none.

### Personal Power Building

- ▶ Life space experience is more powerful than talking.
- Real choices involve some risk.
- Sometimes failure or poor choices teach more than success.
- Skilled CYC practitioners know how much choice to create.
- ▶ Share the responsibility when things go badly.
- ▶ Celebrate power that creates hope and growth.
